



Hop, Waddle, Stomp is an up-and-active puzzle game for toddlers. Your child will have fun tossing the ball and hopping around the room, and they'll be learning along the way!

- **fine and gross motor skills** • **animal recognition** • **color matching**
- **following directions** • **taking turns**

Includes:

- 1 Soft Ball
- 8 Puzzle Boards (8 Animal Boards and 16 Animal Cards)



Get to Know the Game

First, carefully remove the pieces from their punchboard frames from back to front and discard any plastic bags and punchboard frames. If the ball gets dirty, you can wash it in the washing machine in cold water.

Before you play, look at the puzzle pieces with your child. What are the animals? Where do they live? Which babies belong to which parents? What sounds or movements do each of the animals make? Make the noises and movements and have your child mimic you. Now, practice throwing the ball. Can you name the color on top?



Try separating the animal boards from the animal cards and mixing them up. Show your child how to match the animal cards to the boards and put them together.

Instructions

For Younger Children

Object

The animals have been outside playing, and it's time for them to come home! Work together to get all of the animals back to their families.

Set Up

- Put the 8 animal boards around the room.
- Put the animal cards in 4 face-down stacks according to color.
- The youngest player gets the ball and goes first.

How to Play

On your turn, throw the ball. What color is face up? Take an animal card of that color and turn it over. Which animal is it? Bring the animal to its family and act like the animal on your way! Waddle like the penguin, hop like the bunny, and roar like the lion! Add the animal card to the animal board.



Now it's the next player's turn. If you roll a color and all the cards of that color are gone, throw the ball again.

Winning

Everyone wins when all of the animals are back with their families! For a more challenging game, spread the animal boards around the house. Can you remember where each animal family is?

For Older Children

Object

Be the first player to complete their animal boards.

Set Up

- Divide the animal boards up evenly among the players. Any extra boards can go back in the box along with their animal cards.
- Spread out the animal cards face down in the middle of the play area.

How to Play

On your turn, throw the ball and choose any animal card that matches the color shown. Does the animal fit on one of your boards? If so, add it to your board. If not, put it back face-down in the middle of the play area.

Now it's the next player's turn.

If a player throws a color and there are no animals cards left of that color, they can throw the ball again. If there is only one color left, the player can choose any card of that color without throwing the ball.

Winning

The first player to complete their animal boards wins. Keep playing until all players have completed their boards.

Solo Play

Your child can play the game for Young Children on their own or just practice putting the puzzle boards together and taking them apart.
